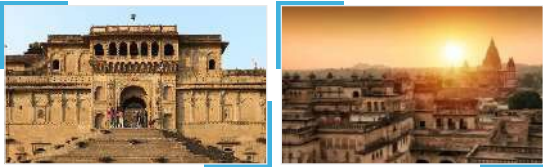

YOGA

Yoga is the physical, mental and spiritual practices that aim to transform mind, body and soul. The origins of Yoga have been speculated to date back to pre-vedic Indian traditions, but most likely developed around the sixth and the fifth century BC. The earliest accounts of yoga-practices are in the Buddhist Nikayas. Yoga gurus from India later introduced yoga to the west, following the success of Swami Vivekananda in the late 19th and an early 20th century. In the 1980s, then yoga became popular as a system of physical exercise across the Western world.

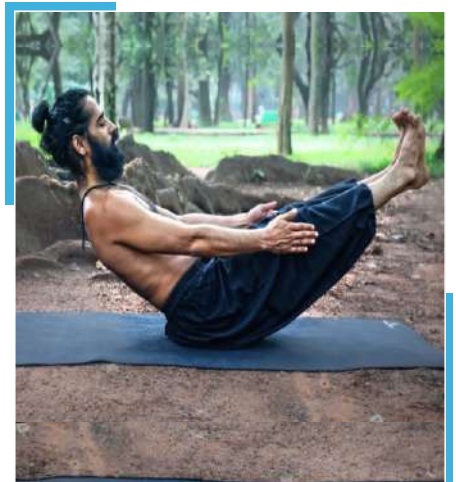
India offers a host of opportunities to learn the disciplines of yoga. Yoga Retreats are located in North India close to Rishikesh along the banks of River Ganges.

An aesthetic combination of Yoga and Ayurveda is extensively available in the Southern state of Kerala.

Ayurveda

Ayurveda is considered a form of medical care, equal to conventional Western medicine, traditional Chinese medicine, naturopathic medicine, and homeopathic medicine.

By the medieval period, Ayurvedic practitioners developed a number of medicinal preparations and surgical procedures for the treatment of various ailments. Practices that are derived from Ayurvedic medicine are regarded as part of complementary and alternative medicine and along with Siddha Medicine and Traditional Chinese medicine. Ayurveda is well integrated into the Indian National health care system, with state hospitals for Ayurveda established across the country.
